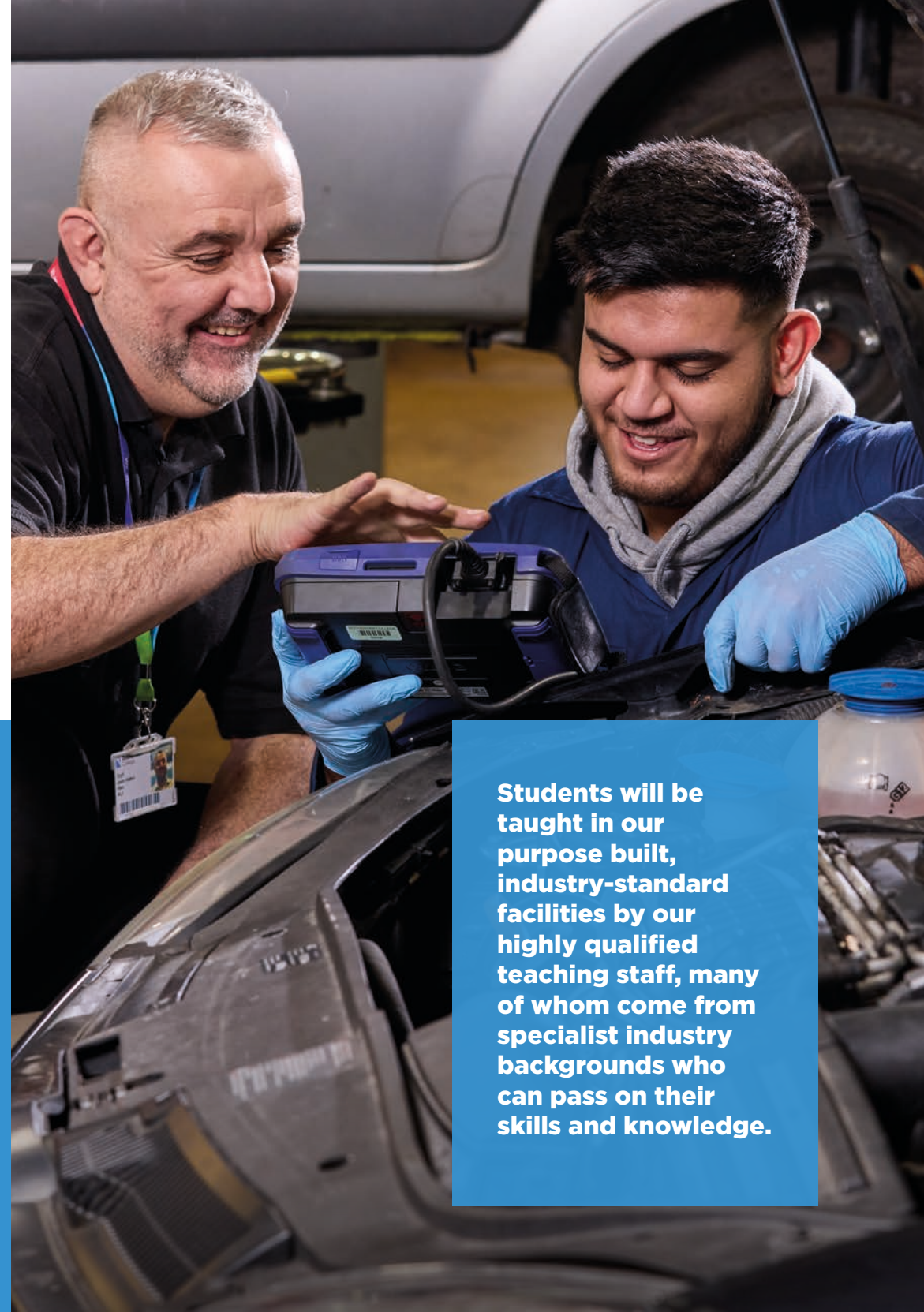
PROGRAMMES

All of our programmes are designed to:

- Equip students with real-life, hands-on skills to prepare them for their future career
- Develop resilience and self-awareness
- Help raise aspirations and attainment
- Support transition into post-16 education

We have a wide range of technical options which includes Construction, Hair and Beauty, Hospitality and Catering, Land-based Industries, Motor Vehicle and Sport.

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Students will be taught in our purpose built, industry-standard facilities by our highly qualified teaching staff, many of whom come from specialist industry backgrounds who can pass on their skills and knowledge.

Bespoke Groups

We are able to offer provision to Year 10 and Year 11 students in a variety of subject areas, including:

- Catering and Hospitality
- Childcare
- Construction
- Engineering
- Foundation Learning
- Hair and Beauty
- Land-based Industries
- Sport
- Visual and Performing Arts

Students would usually be in a bespoke group made up of pre-16-year olds, attending College for one or two days per week and work towards an accredited qualification/non-accredited courses.

The vocational programme would also offer support to a progression route into post-16 study and help prepare students for further learning or employment.

Requests for this provision needs to be made before the Easter holiday to ensure adequate planning time.

Infills

Students can apply to infill onto any of the following subject areas:

- Art (including Fashion and Graphic Design)*
- Business

- Construction

This will provide students with an exciting insight into our different courses that will prepare them for a chosen accredited College course the following year, either with us or elsewhere.

Attending the sessions will also give the students an opportunity to discover what College life is like through meeting their peers and members of staff and getting hands-on within their chosen subject.

School submits their students' applications along with all appropriate documentation

(e.g. SEN information/EHCPs/pastoral report).

4.

Students attend a pre-entry interview and initial assessment to assess suitability for the programme and discuss any support needs.

3.

Students and parents are invited to attend a College Open Event.

5.

Students are sent conditional offers and taster sessions are arranged with school.

6.

Students attend a College induction and enrol on their chosen programme.

School Partnership Provision Rates

Our school partnership provision rates are outlined below:

The rates outlined are subject to students not having any significant support needs. We will work with you further to determine rates if a student is identified as requiring support on either a one-to-one or shared basis.

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What's Included?

1. Arrangement of pre-entry interviews for all students to ensure they are suitable for the programme chosen by the school.
2. Full College induction programme, including health and safety.
3. College ID and white lanyard to make these students easily identifiable as under 16s.
4. Tools, equipment and materials required for all practical and classroom-based areas of the programme.
5. Daily attendance reports to your school's designated point of contact.
6. Termly reports to your school, the student and their parents.
7. Regular contact between College and school regarding any behavioural issues or concerns.
8. A guaranteed post-16 place at College for students that have achieved 95%+ attendance and fully complete their course.

Further Details

Invoicing

Invoices will be issued termly to schools. All student places are subject to a six week probationary period at the start of their programme.

For students who remain at the College after this period, the school will be charged the full rate for the year.

Equipment/ Uniforms

School will be informed about any equipment or uniform requirements and can work with College to source this for their learners.

Free School Meals

Students who are in receipt of free school meals will be provided with meals whilst attending their College course.

The College should be made aware of the names of students who are in receipt of free school meals prior to the start of the course. Free school meals are charged to the school at a cost of £2.50 per day and will be included on the school's invoice.

***Please note that school meals will be chargeable regardless of attendance.**
