Tuition Fees

The cost of this tuition is fully funded for 16-18-year old's. However, if this is your second enrolment at Level 3, or you are over 18 in year 2, you may be required to source an adult learning loan through SFE.

Learners aged 19+ may be eligible for funding if they have an EHCP.
