This

Importantly, this course meets DEFRA's recommended baseline qualification requirements for staff working in licensed dog boarding, kenneling, or day-care establishments.

What Will I Study?

You will study modules focused on canine care, welfare, and behaviour. Key topics include:

- Understanding normal canine behaviour and body language.

- Implementing suitable routines to prevent welfare and behavioural issues.
- Providing effective environmental enrichment.
- Understanding appropriate, force-free training techniques.
- Identifying common canine diseases, disorders, and early signs of pain or illness.
- Safe feeding, hygiene, and handling routines.
